DALTON - James Joseph Brennan, 49, of 73 Daly Ave., died Sunday morning at Berkshire Medical Center after being stricken at home.

Born in Pittsfield on Aug. 31, 1952, son of Donald J. and Mary Miller Brennan, he graduated from Deerfield Academy in 1971 and from Williams College in 1975.

At the time of his death, Mr. Brennan was a purchasing agent for General Dynamics, where he had been employed for 20 years.

He was a communicant of St. Agnes' Church and had taught Confraternity of Christian Doctrine at one time. He enjoyed fishing and hunting and was a member of the National Rifle Association.

He and his wife, the former Margaret Betit, were married June 28, 1975.
