BRONFMAN, Melanie Mann died on December 31, 1991 at her home in Atherton, California at the age of 37, from breast cancer. She grew up in Los Angeles where she graduated from St. Matthew's School, Pacific Palisades in 1965 and Westlake School in 1971. She graduated cum laude and Phi Beta Kappa from Williams College in 1975. After her marriage to Sam Bronfman II in 1976, she attended Stanford Law School, receiving her JD in 1983. The Bronfmans then moved to Rye, NY, where she was active in community affairs and was a member of the New York State Bar Association. Their two children were born in New York. The family returned to California in 1987 when Sam became President of the Sea Classics Wine Co. Melanie gave generously of her time and talents to Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Menlo Park, Trinity Child and Family Institute, the chaplaincy program at Stanford University Hospital, the Northern California Cancer Center, Williams College, St. Matthew's Parish Music Program and the San Francisco Zoological Society. She is survived by her husband; a son, Max; a daughter, Dana, all of Atherton her parents, Peter H. and Carlotta Mann of Los Angeles; her sister and brother-in-law, Sarah and Michael Newman and her nephew, Christopher, of Pacific Palisades; her brother and sister-in-law, Peter and Pamela Mann of Los Angeles; her brother and sister-in-law, William and Linda Mann of Malvern, PA; her grandmother Marion H. Mann of Los Angeles.

A Memorial Service will be held at 11am Saturday (today) at Holy Trinity Episcopal Church in Menlo Park. Another will be held at St. Matthew's Episcopal Church, Pacific Palisades, at 2 pm Saturday, January 11.
